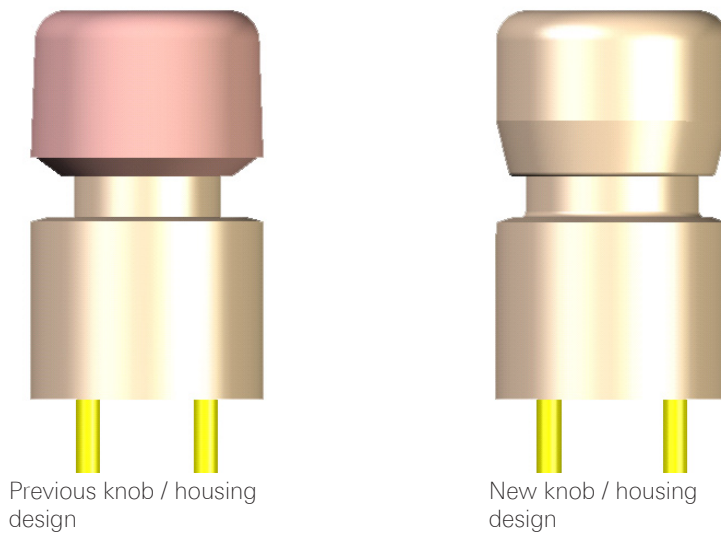

The Worlds smallest Push Button - PB 100 Just got better!

Sonion quality philosophy continuously adds more value to our products for the purpose of exceeding market quality requirements.

Therefore, we are pleased to announce that we have achieved a more robust component by reducing the 'fingernail catch' between the Housing and the Knob on our PB 100 Switch. This is achieved by a slight re-design of the Knob and Housing.

This optimization of the design has minimized a potential risk of pulling out the Knob from the Housing by a fingernail.

The visual appearance (form) has been changed slightly, however it will not have any overall affect on the fit and function of the PB 100. Consequently, this change will have no influence on the part numbers that you order today. The improvement will be implemented in week 07, 2006. The change can be easily identified by the visual appearance of the knob itself, as shown earlier in this document.

The new design of the PB 100 has been qualified according to our internal Sonion Qualification Procedures.
