## RoHS 2011/65/EU

Sonion certifies that all components manufactured by us are RoHS compliant according to the definitions and restrictions given by the European Parliament (Directive 2011/65/EU) and the Council of 8 June 2011, with regards to the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.


## Sonion actions

At Sonion we have taken all reasonable steps to confirm our suppliers' statements regarding the absence of the restricted substances. Compliance status by our suppliers along with occasional testing ensures that products do not contain any of the restricted substances referred to in Article 4(l) and named in Annex II of the RoHS Directive at concentrations in excess of those permitted under the RoHS Directive. When it is not technically possible to remove such substances we will explain why, and why the existence in the products at levels in excess of those concentrations is allowed as one of the particular applications listed in Annex III and IV to the directive.
